A RETURN TO THE RENAISSANCE

WHAT BECAME KNOWN AS THE RENAISSANCE BEGAN IN ITALY MORE THAN 500 YEARS AGO as an age of adventure and curiosity, spreading to the rest of Europe from the 14th through the 16th Centuries. It reached England by 1485 following the War of Roses and it was during this time that Sir Thomas More, Christopher Marlowe, and William Shakespeare introduced works that established the English Renaissance and influenced literature and drama.

Faires became popular in Europe during this time and farmers, villagers and peddlers would gather in sun-filled meadows to barter livestock and goods. From year to year the gathering and pageantry grew, and so came minstrels, troubadours, dancers, actors and mongers of all sorts.



KING RICHARD'S FAIRE IS A RE-CREATION OF JUST SUCH A RENAISSANCE PERIOD MARKETPLACE. FROM food and fairings (crafts) to entertainment and costuming, every aspect of the Faire captures the essence of this exciting historical period.

On the occasion of the Tennial Celebration — the 10th anniversary — of the reign of the Great King Richard, a seven-part serial drama, "Crisis in the Realm," unfolds offering Faire-goers a new chapter each of the Faire weekends.

Thus, in a proclamation to his realm, His Majesty has announced plans for "more merriment, more wares, more food and spirit and more family fun."

DO YE BELIEVE IN UNICORNS?



As a special tribute to King Richard's 10-year reign, one of four living unicorns will visit the realm for the first two weekends of the Faire. For more than 4,000 years the unicorn has fascinated the world.

Given the limited documentation of ancient history, it is difficult to separate myth from truth about this creature with its silky white coat, tufted beard, cloven hooves, golden eyes and single golden horn.

But sources have alleged that unicorns were bred by early tribes

and societies to lead herd animals. With its centrally positioned single horn, the unicorn would become the leader and protector of his herd. The centered horn functioned as a weapon—its position on the foreskull allowing the leader to take accurate aim in a fight. Legends such as the unicorn in battle with the lion developed. (This legend is depicted on the coat of arms of England). But the unicorn's aggressive nature is not all it has to offer. Widely depicted in early European tapestry, painting and statuary, the unicorn is now, as it has always been, an artistic creation — a living art form.

The unicorn is located between The Black Swan Inn and the Troll Bridge.

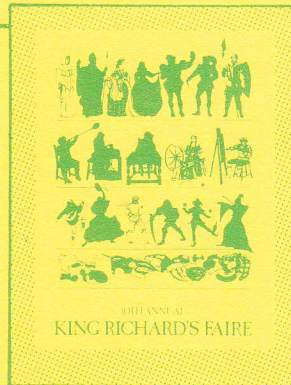
