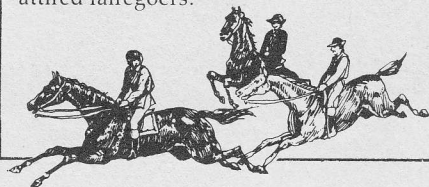
HIS MAJESTY'S MUSIC FESTIVAL July 9, 10

The Ballad contest for pre-registered contestants will be featured on Sunday.

THE KING'S RACES July 16, 17

King Richard, ever the enthusiastic sportsman, has commanded that visitors to the realm this weekend shall be treated to races of many varieties. Featured will be: Two separate days of Cross Country Horse Races with five and ten mile races each day and a total weekend purse of \$2000; Open Field Sighthound Races (on Sunday) coordinated by the Midwest Coursing Club; The Lord Chancellor's Foot Races for teams of 4 (2 male/2 female) open to inhabitants of the realm and suitably attired fairegoers.

FESTIVAL OF MAGIC July 30, 31

As if by magic, countless magicians and occultists will descend upon the Fair summoned by mysterious and unknown forces. Magical feats performed by some of the area's finest magicians and wizards from the Society of American Magicians, Assembly 148, and the College of Wizards, will amaze and astound visitors to the Faire.

PIRATES REVEL August 6, 7

A band of swashbuckling pirates, having lost their fabulous treasure chest to the Chancellor Blackwell, will seek shelter at the Crow's Nest until they can determine how to recover their prized booty. During this time they seek to amuse themselves by inventing outrageous games and contests, pitting members of their merry band against individuals foolhardy enough to challenge them.

CARNIVAL OF FOOLS August 13, 14

To celebrate with frolicsome foolishness and hilarity the end of King Richard's 11th Faire and a return to order within the realm, the fools of the village crown a "King of the Fools" to reign over the completely foolish activities planned for the carnival. Included will be "The Most Foolish Contest" with cash awards totaling \$500.00, Fool's Parade, coronation and banquet and a myriad of other foolish and silly things. Saturday will be highlighted by the ever popular Hound Show with cash awards in six categories including Best Costumed Dog and Owner and The Sir Benji Award for all around excellence.

BECOME AN APPRENTICE

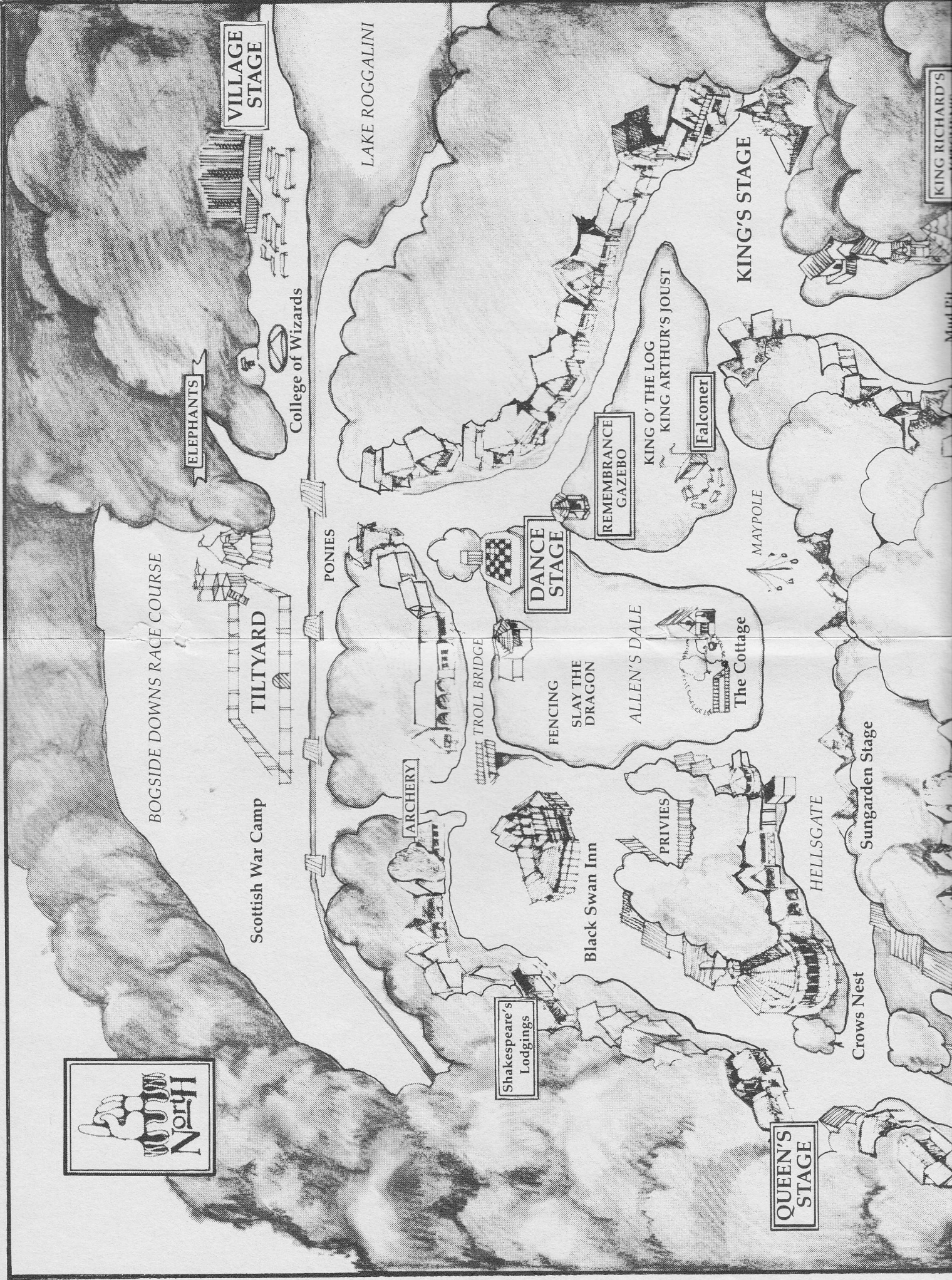

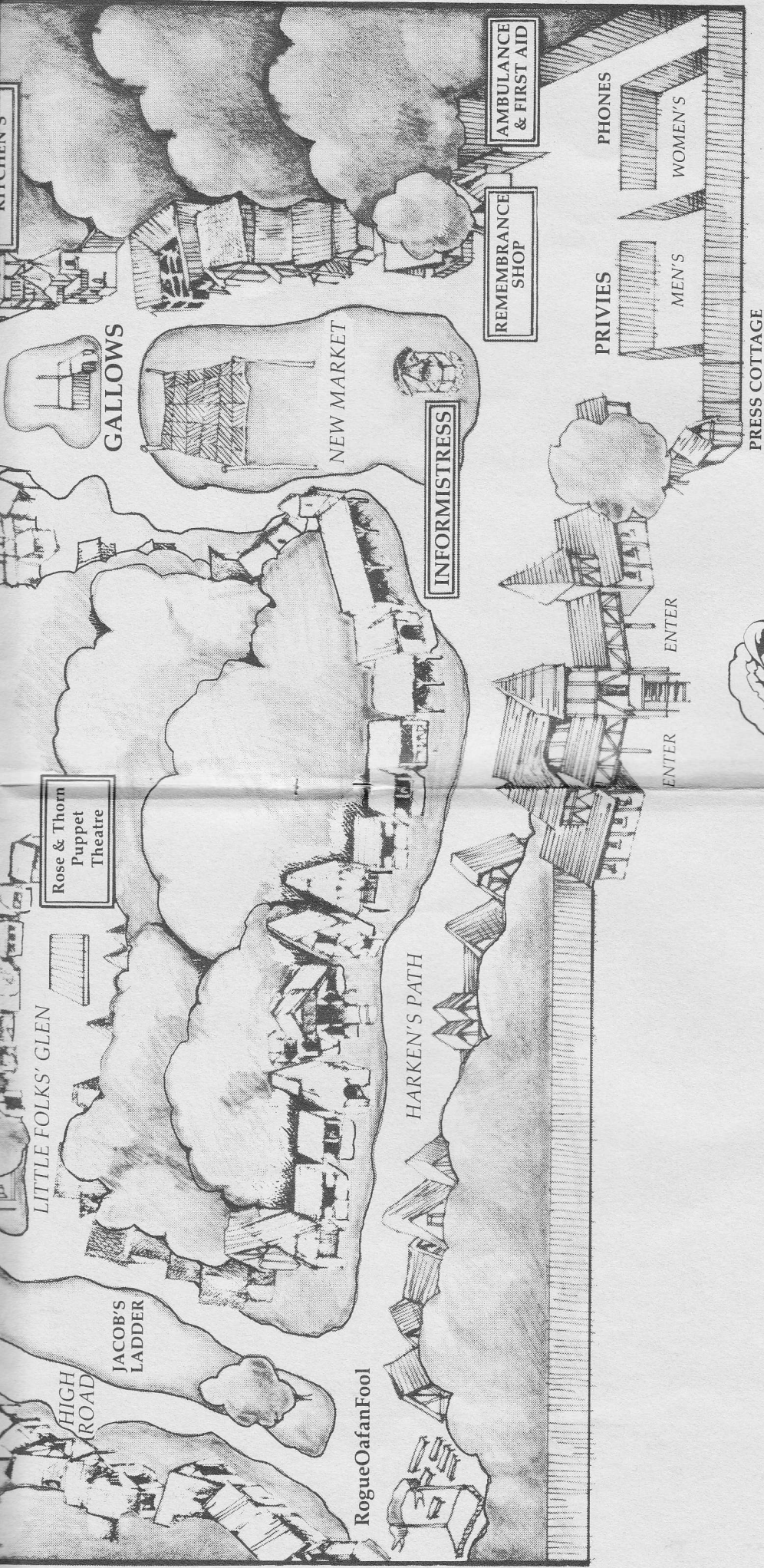
